\$4.4 Million in Scholarships Earned by Keith Country Day Students

ROCKFORD, IL – Thirty-one Keith Country Day School seniors have amassed \$4,400,000 in college scholarships according to Cindy Hill, Keith college counselor.

Considered one of the area's top college preparatory schools for more than 94 years, the class of 2010's impressive total marks the ninth consecutive year that a Keith graduating class (of less than 35), totaled more than one million dollars in scholarships. It also marks the seventh consecutive year that 70% or more of the graduating class earned at least one college scholarship each.

"We are so proud of this class," said Head of School, Alan Gibby. "In talking with some of the faculty, \$4.4 million is the largest scholarship total we've seen reported this year from any school or any school district. It is truly a remarkable total by a very talented group."

The Class of 2010 will receive their diplomas tonight at graduation, which will be at the Tebala Shrine Temple at 7 p.m. Some of the colleges these graduates class will be attending this fall include Brown University, Northwestern University, University of Michigan, University of Notre Dame, Drake University and the University of Pennsylvania to name a few.
