## **MATH TEAM WINS ICTM REGIONAL**

ROCKFORD, IL – Fourteen members of the Keith math team demonstrated their skills on February 23 by winning the Illinois Council of Teachers regional math competition.

Mentored by Mathematics Department Chair, Raeann Jurgens, students competed in one of four basic math subject areas, in both individual and team events. The subject areas included Algebra, Geometry, Algebra II and pre-Calculus.

The three-round competition hosted over 300 students from approximately 20 area schools. By winning the regional, Keith's team has qualified for the April state finals. In addition to winning the overall competition, Keith placed first in eight different team events.
